Directions For Use

Stir Ultrafix Remover before use. Using a paintbrush, generously apply Ultrafix Remover Gel to the glue-covered surface or soak glue-covered surface in Ultrafix Remover Liquid. Allow it to stand for a minimum of one hour and longer for thicker coats of glue. Using a scraper, such as a paint scraper, remove Ultrafix Remover along with the loosened glue. Carefully rinse off excess before using a pressure washer to remove any remaining gel and loosened glue. Repeat if necessary.
